ADDITIONAL GUIDANCE

We have done our best this year to offer a wider range of options choices as we seek to accommodate the preferences of each and every student.

However, we would ask you to be aware of the following:

- We reserve the right to withdraw a subject from the options offer in circumstances where very few pupils opt for this particular subject. We have a duty to ensure that our provision is cost effective, and that we are making best use of the resources we have to benefit the greatest number of pupils. This may mean that we need to ask a small number of students to reconsider their options choices.
- We also ask you to be aware that we may not be able to offer your desired option combination if your forms are returned after the final date specified below. This is because some subjects have strict capacity constraints, determined by the amount of accommodation and equipment available, and the more popular subjects can reach full capacity early on in the options process. It is possible that some subjects may be closed to students after this date.
- We also reserve the right to allocate students to subject classes with the aim of evening out class sizes to provide equality of access to teaching and learning opportunities. This means that students should not allow the options choices of friends to influence their decisions as the final class lists may not always strictly reflect option block choices.
- Once a pupil has embarked upon a course in September, changes of subject are permitted in exceptional circumstances and where class sizes permit in the first half term only. Pupils will not be allowed to change courses after the first half term of study.
