Application Requirements

Applicants must provide evidence in most and/or all of these areas:

1. Academic excellence, with a minimum of 6 A* grades at IGCSE or its equivalent
2. Comprehensive involvement and accomplishments in various areas of study
3. Active participation in the wider community and service learning
4. Demonstration of leadership qualities

Application Checklist

1. Application for Admission form and required documents

Please complete an [online Application for Admission form](#) on the GIS website and provide all required documents as stated on the checklist. Additionally, a signed copy of the [GIS Scholarship 2026 Terms and Conditions](#) must be uploaded upon application.

2. Personal Statement

Please prepare a 500-word Personal Statement on one A4 page using Arial font, size 10 point. In your statement, clearly outline your strengths and abilities, and explain how you can contribute to Garden International School.

3. Reports and Certificates

- School reports from the past two years;
- Academic and co-curricular certificates and awards from the past two years;
- Results from IGCSE/equivalent mock exams;
- Predicted grades for IGCSE/equivalent;
- Copies of attained IGCSE/equivalent certificates (if any).

4. Teacher's Recommendation

A recommendation letter from the Head Teacher or Class Tutor of your current or most recent school, detailing your academic and co-curricular achievements.



5. Creative Arts Applicants

Applicants who are keen on a creative arts scholarship must study at least one creative arts subject at A Level (such as music, drama, photography, or art) and are expected to actively participate in GIS's creative arts programme and co-curricular opportunities:

- School Symphonic Orchestra: Performing at concerts and events.
- School Musical Theatre Production: Participating in the annual musical theatre show, which may involve singing, acting, dancing, or playing in the show band.
- The Big Draw: Engaging in the whole-school visual arts festival featuring various exhibitions and events.
- Curating Exhibitions: Working with the Visual Arts faculty to develop skills in art curation.
- Drama Performances: Auditioning for and supporting various drama productions.

Applicants should showcase their creative excellence by submitting one or more of the following practical/composition:

- Drama: A solo acting performance video, including an introductory explanation of the performance.
- Music: A video of a solo musical performance and/or a notated composition (.xml file).
- Art: A portfolio of 3-5 pieces of art, design, or photography that illustrates the creative process.

6. Scholarship Application Submission
